As a part of co-curricular activity in my graduation, I was enrolled in NPTEL online course by the Department of Biochemistry. NPTEL stands for **National program for Technology Enhanced Learning**. It is an initiative by 7 Indian institutes of technology (I.I.T. Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, and Roorkee) and the Indian Institute of science. As India needs many more teachers for effective implementation of higher education in professional courses, these types of practices are primarily helpful to teachers, scholars, and students like me. NPTEL has a total of 420 web courses and 509 video courses. Out of those courses, I have selected the **HEALTH RESEARCH FUNDAMENTALS** course to accomplish. It is a free online course in the medium of English. The duration of the course is eight weeks long. National Institute of Epidemiology (N.I.E.), Indian council of medical research (ICMR), has offered this program on human biomedical research.

All of them were highly designated and are worthy illustrators.

It was an excellent experience while pursuing the course as it's a lifetime opportunity to interact with the I.I.T. Professors. For a government college student like me, it was a dream come a moment to have an I.I.T. range certificate-NPTEL at a meagre cost. After attending the eight-week course with thoroughly graded weekly assignments. **My friends Shahid Ali, Lalitha bhargavi, P. Krupani have participated in the online exam at N.R.I. college, Agiripalli. The price of Ambition- Richard III, Macbeth, Julius Caesar, Cymbeline Titus Andronicus, King Lear, king John, much Ado About Nothing, Antony and Cleopatra, Richard II, Henry v, Henry IV pt.1, The Tempest.




