**UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF Dr.VELAGA JOSHI, PRINCIPAL-Chairperson**

1. Minutes of meetings of all Board of studies are confirmed.

2. Scheme, framework of undergraduate courses are approved with following points:

(a) College has decided to follow APSCHE revised syllabus for Foundation courses under CBCS system for all undergraduate programmes with 10 foundation courses in the three year undergraduate programme.

(b) College has decided to follow revised common framework of CBCS for colleges framed by APSHE (revised in April 2016) for BA, B.Com and B.Sc courses with change in allotment of marks for internal and external Marks.

(c) College has decided to allot **60% marks for external exams and 40% for internal exams**. Each department has framed their modalities for distribution of internal marks according to their subject requirements in Board of studies meeting.

3. Syllabus of all the subjects for I and II Semesters as confirmed by Board of studies was approved.

## **(b) Academic regulations**

- (i) Eligibility for Admissions in under graduate Courses-**Intermediate, Intermediate (Vocational) with Bridge course certificate. Reservation policies and roaster system of AP state Government will be followed in admission process.
- (ii) Resolution:** It is resolved to ask the Government to allow Polytechnic students for Industrial Oriented/Restructured courses, since Polytechnic is equivalent to Intermediate
- (iii) Eligibility for Admissions in Post graduate Courses:** Undergraduate Degree with one of the selected subject as one of the three subjects in undegraduation. Preference may be given to rank holders of different PG CET's. College may conduct separate exam for those students who had not attended any University PG entrance for admission.

5. Confirmed the Model papers for all subjects approved by all Board of studies.

### **6. Approved the following regulations for Sports persons, NCC and NSS students**

- (a)** Re-exam of internal exams will be conducted if the student is in a tournament or training
- (b)** 1% grace marks will be given to the meritorious players for pass percentages in the subjects on the recommendation of Physical Directors
- (c)** 10% Bonus marks will be given to Medal Winners at National level/International level
- (d)** 5% Bonus marks will be given to medal winners at South Zone level, inter University levels
- (e)** It is approved to pay Participation fee, T.A and D.A for NSS, NCC for participants in National and State level Competitions.

**7. Extra Curricular activities-**Approved to pay Participation fee, T.A and D.A for students who participated and win prizes in inter University, State and National level extra-curricular activities.

**8. Student Assistant ship-** It is approved to give student Assistant-ship for Languages, Arts, Science and Commerce groups (One student for each above said groups) at the rate of Rs.2000/- per month.

9. It is suggested to the Governing Body to give permission for Empowered Cell for Disabled.





