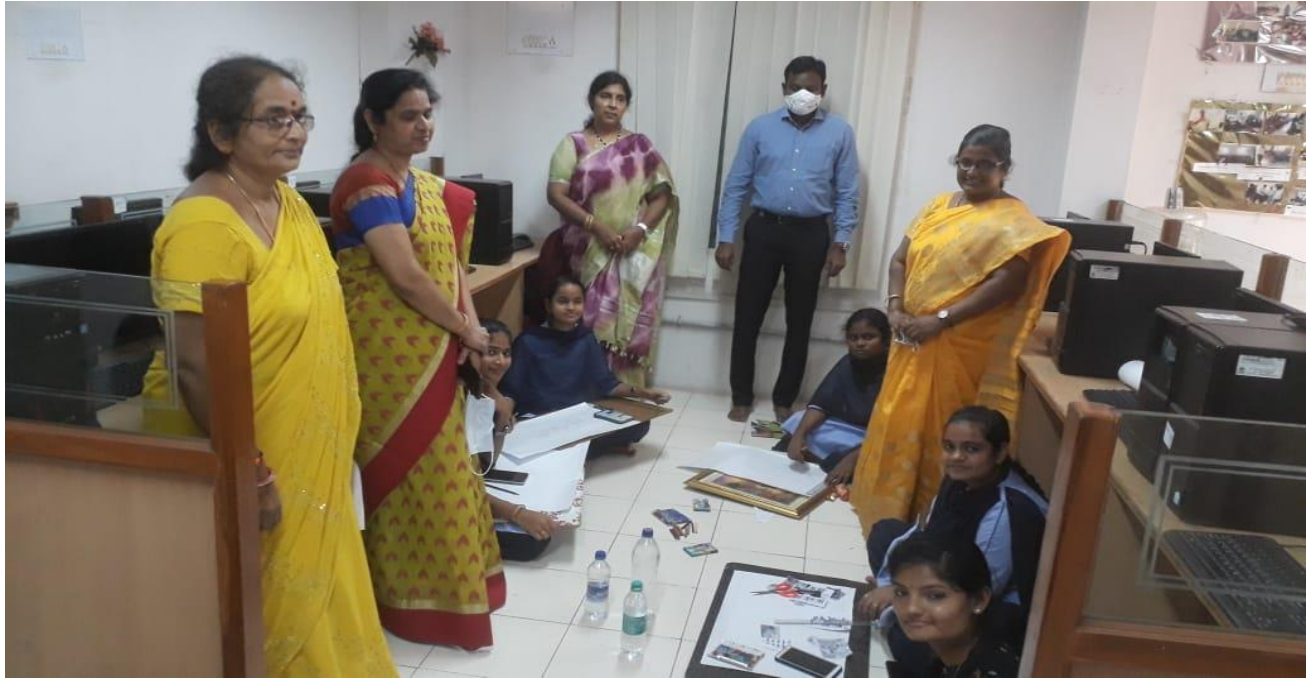
- Collage describes both the technique and resulting work of an art in which pieces of paper, photographs are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface.

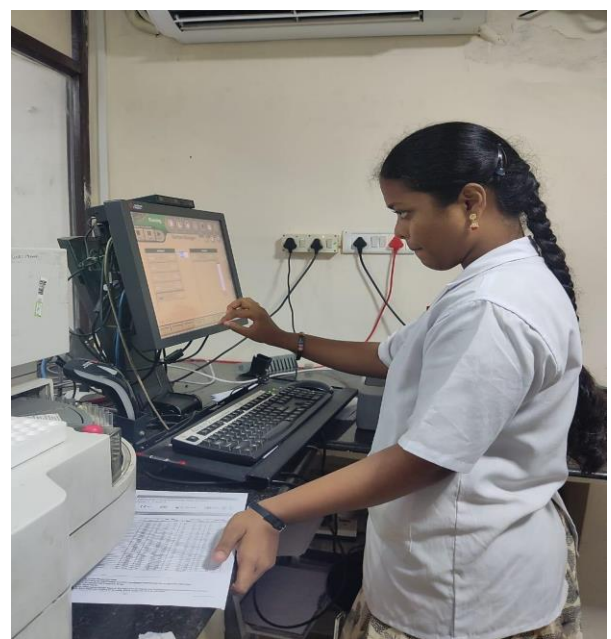

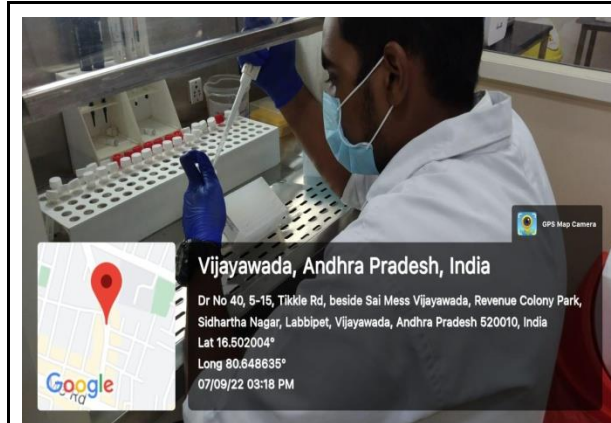

Less energy is used to produce paper from waste paper than it does from wood, So less CO₂ produced in the manufacturing process and less methane is produced from the paper breaking down in landfill.

It takes less water to break down waste paper than it does to break down wood.

If paper recycling is used to the full potential, wood is only needed once to produce 5 cycles of paper which also means saving waste from landfill 5 times.

It only takes 1.2 ton of waste paper to produce 1 ton of recycled paper whereas it takes 2.5 ton of wood to produce 1 ton of virgin fiber paper.

The Practice

The used papers, Books are collected from the SRR & CVR Government Degree College by the **Department of Physics** and sold to the Recycling Company with the association of ITC WoW program.

To save trees and to protect the environment waste, an MoU is taken from the Recycling company to sell used paper and books of SRR & CVR Government Degree College(A), Vijayawada.

6 tons of used paper and carton is collected from all the departments of the college from 2018 to 2022 and the paper recycling company Suraj Krishna Greeneries associated with ITC picks this dry waste and pays for it as per the market value from the year 2018 to until now.

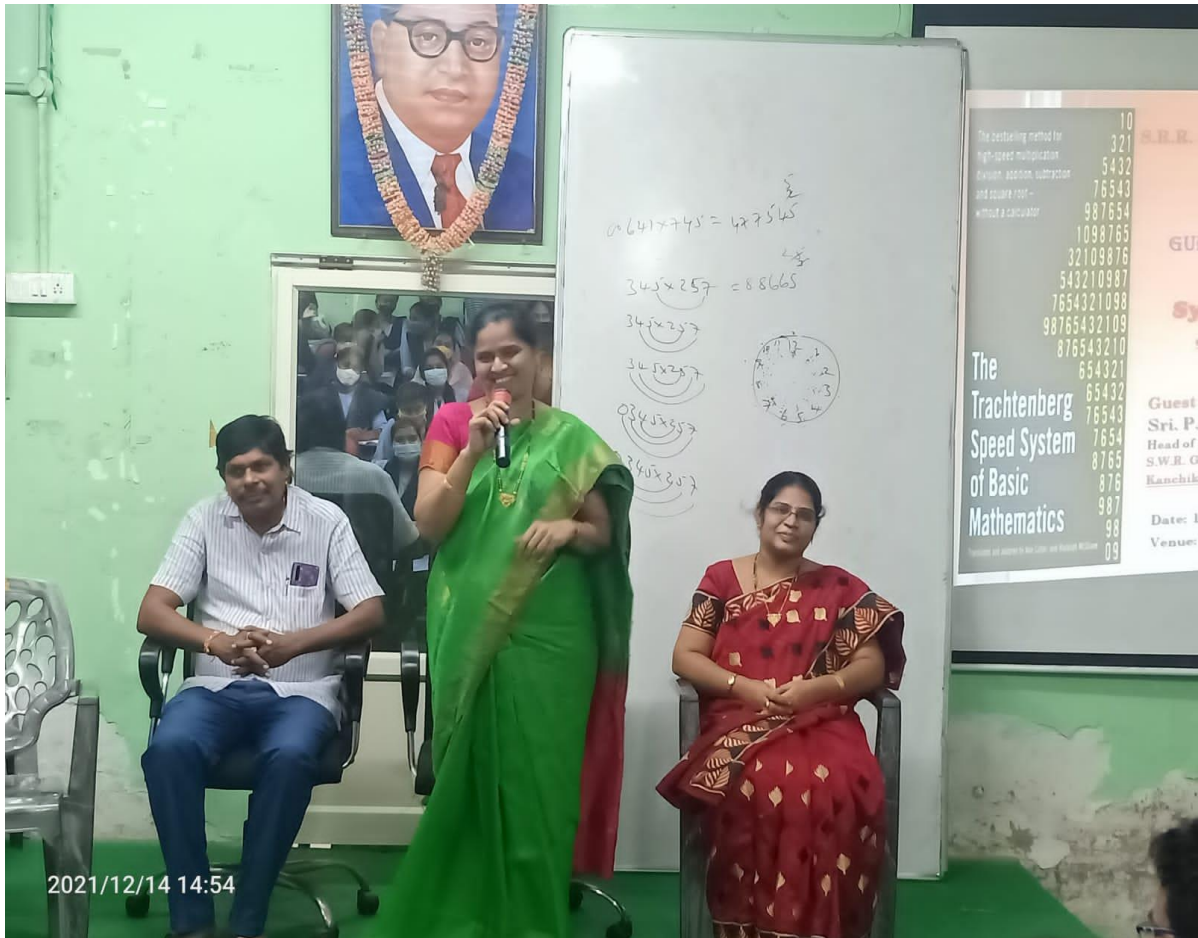

- Understand the nuances of cultural differences as they relate to teamwork, negotiation and leadership
- The way to improve their presentation skills in a Persuasive and professional mode

- And learn to foster collaboration of teamwork using their creativity and communication skills

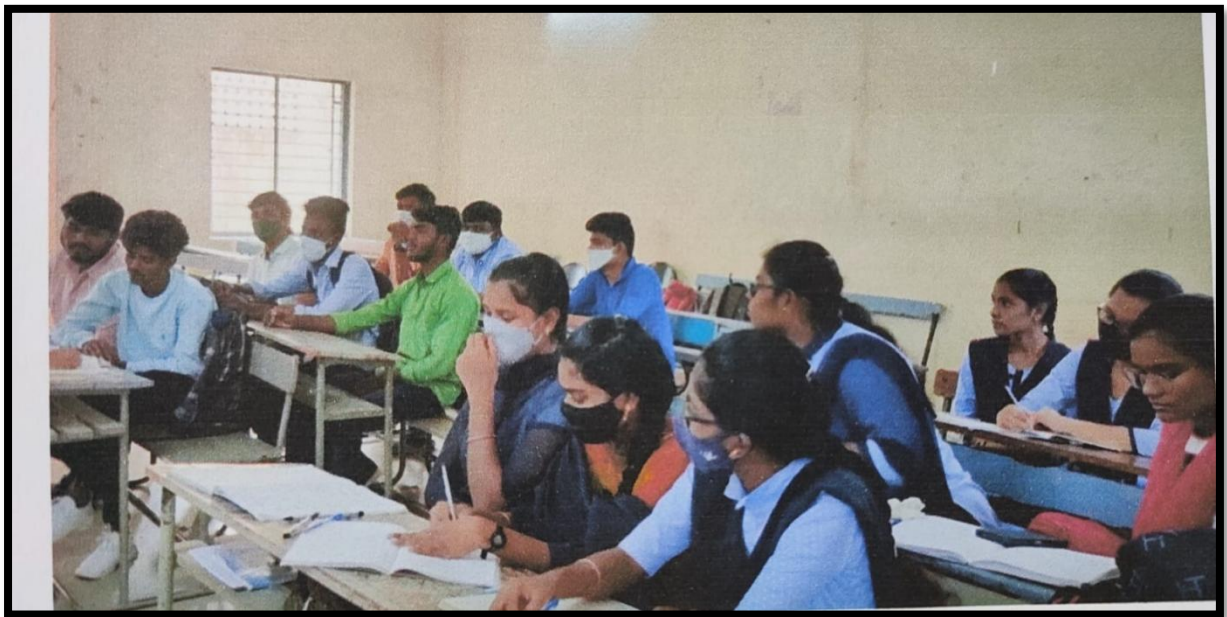
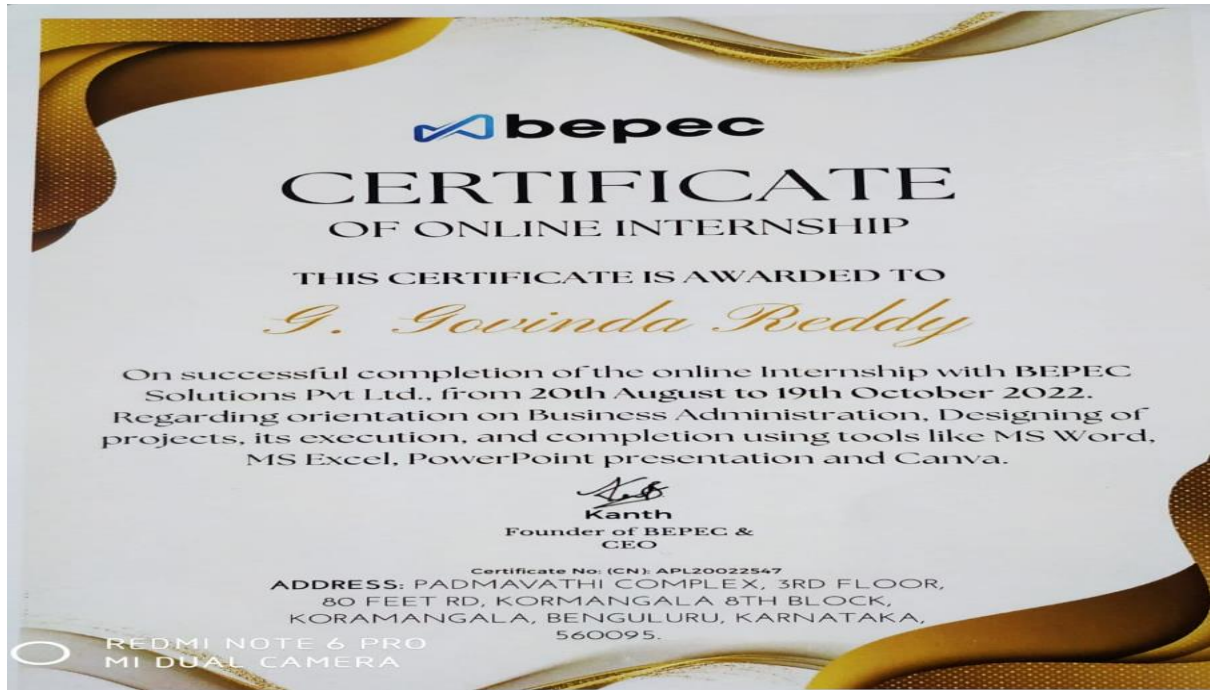
Activity with BEPEC SOLUTIONS :

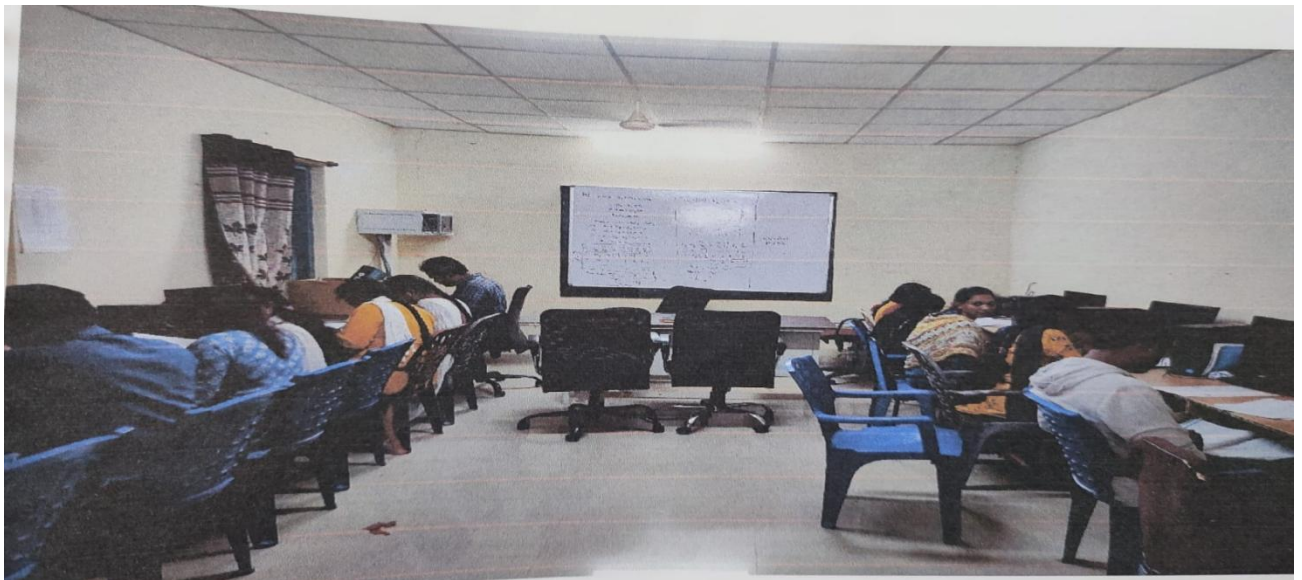

DIAGNOSTIC LAB EQUIPMENT

Blood gas analyzer: Blood gas analysis which is also known as arterial blood gas analysis is a test in which the amounts of oxygen and carbon dioxide as well as the acidity (pH) of the blood are measured. It may also measure electrolytes and metabolites.



It is used to check acid-base balance for individuals having heart or kidney failure, severe sleep problem, uncontrolled diabetes or a drug overdose. This test is done in cases of lungs problem or severe breathing as COPD , asthma etc.

Biochemistry Analyzer

An automated Biochemical analyser is a medical diagnostic lab equipment which is designed to measure different chemicals and other characteristics in a number of biological samples with minimal human assistance. The blood and other fluid which are measured are used for diagnosis of disease. The automation of this test has reduced the time of analysis from days to hours.

Centrifuge

A laboratory Centrifuge is a motor driven equipment which spins liquid samples at high speed. A centrifuge is used for the separation of fluids, gas or liquid, based on density. Separation is achieved by spinning a vessel containing material at high speed; the centrifugal force pushes heavier materials to the outside of the vessel.

Hematology Analyser / Cell counter

A cell-counter and bio-chemistry analyser are the most basic diagnostic lab equipment required – as blood cell count and blood profile are most commonly written tests.

Urine analyzer

It is used to performing automatic urine testing. Urine analyser analyses bilirubin, protein, glucose and red blood cells. There are many models which contain urine strip readers, a type of reflectance photometer that can process several hundred strips per hour.

It helps to find the illness if any in the early stages which includes kidney disease, liver disease, diabetes etc. Urine test is also done to confirm the pregnancy

Incubator

It is an equipment in a laboratory which is used to grow and maintain microbiological cultures or cell cultures. The incubator maintains optimal temperature, humidity and other conditions such as the carbon dioxide (CO₂) and content of oxygen in the atmosphere inside.

The simplest incubators are the boxes which are insulated with a heater which is adjustable which temperature goes up to 140 to 150 °F. Laboratory incubators gives controlled, contamination-free environment for safe and reliable work with cell and tissue cultures by

specific conditions such as temperature, humidity, and CO₂. Laboratory incubators are used for storage and growth of bacterial cultures.

Elisa Reader/Microplate reader

Also known as microplate readers or microplate photometers, it is used to detect biological, chemical or physical events of samples in microtiter plates. ELISA stands for enzyme linked immunosorbent assay. It is an antibody test or a test for immune response to things attacking the body such as virus, bacteria and allergens. The test is done in an ELISA plate, also known as a 96-well plate or microplate. The ELISA reader reads the plate.

Hot air oven

Hot air ovens are electrical equipment which sterilize using dry heat. Generally, they can be operated from 50 to 300 °C, to control the temperature using a thermostat. Hot air oven have double walled insulation that keeps the heat in and conserves energy, the inner layer being a poor conductor and outer layer being metallic. There is also an air filled space in between to aid insulation. It has an air circulating fan which uniformly distribute the heat. These are fitted with the adjustable wire mesh plated trays and it has switch for on and off and indicators as well for temperature and holding time.

The objective of the programme :

The implementation of GST would be a major milestone in India's indirect tax reforms. It would lessen the negative effects of cascade and open the door to a single national market by combining a significant number of Central and State taxes into a single tax and permitting the set-off of prior-stage taxes. As a result of the implementation leading to higher costs for goods and services, some of them provided favourable responses, while others provided negative ones, raising the possibility that this tax may burden people. So the Department of Commerce, In order to provide awareness to the students about the knowledge of the Goods and Service Tax's application, arranged a Guest Lecture on 8-12-2021.

Abstract of the activity: A chartered accountant from Vijayawada named Sri. Kothamasu L.S.
