On 27.04.2024 AP POLYCET was conducted in the college. The commissioner of Technical Education has inspected the college during the exam.

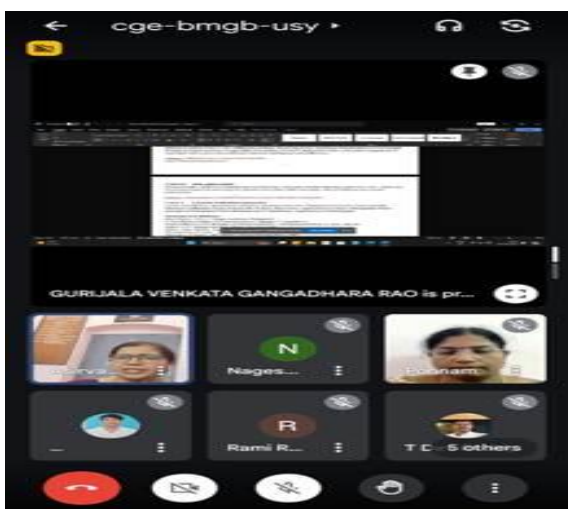


Department of Micro-Biology on 29th April held Board of Studies meeting and taken its approval for Micro-Biology courses on III & IV semesters.
