1. 46th AP Inter district Senior body building championships

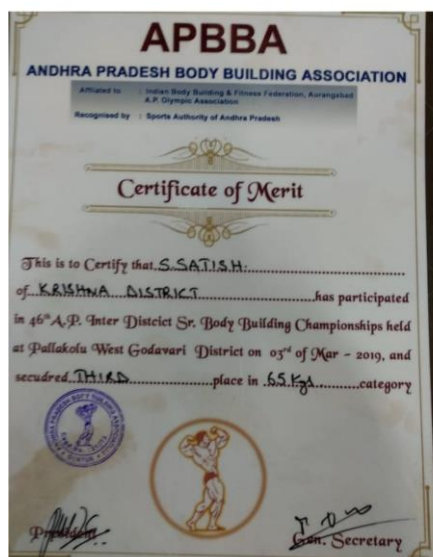
Date: March 2019

Place: Noble college, Machilipatnam

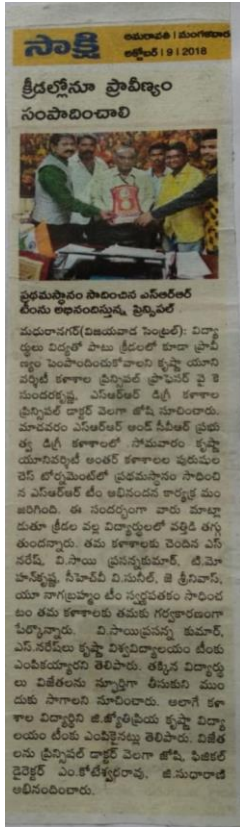
Result: Our team bagged the runner up trophy
