He apprised the members of Board of Studies and the guidelines of the UGC, APSCHE, CCE & University regarding the framing of syllabus, and the recommended evaluation ratio for internal and external examinations. The members discussed in detail the various aspects presented before them and unanimously resolved the following:

Resolutions:

1. Resolved to approve the present syllabus for semester I & II.
2. Resolved to approve the division of marks for internal and external examinations i.e 40 Marks for internal and 60 Marks for external along with the suggested blue print and model question paper.
3. Resolved to approve the list of paper setters and external examiners submitted by the department.
4. Resolved to approve the division of internal marks i.e.
 - a) 10 Marks for Internal Exams i.e., best of two Internal Mid Exams.
 - b) 10 Marks for Assignments (Two).
 - c) 10 Marks for Project work/Group discussion.
 - d) 05 Marks for student seminars/other seminars
 - e) 05 Marks for Viva-voce conducted for students

It is resolved to change the syllabus by adding one sub chapter in M.A. Telugu one unit in a Semester of M.A. Telugu in Unit-5 of 20TEL201 Telugu Sahitya Charithra with the 'Andhra Visaradha' Sri Thapi Dharma Rao Garu, Telugu Writer, Popular Earnest Editor Journalist and whose birthday September 19th was celebrated as Telugu Madhyamala Dinotsvamu, Lyricist, Social Reformer and honoured with Kendra Sahitya Academy Award (1971).

It is is resolved to change the paper of 20TEL106 with Prasara Madhyamalu in the place of Panchatantra Kathalu in Semester-1 of M.A. Telugu Course, as the syllabus of Panchatantra Kathalu is inadequate and not in comprehensive manner. Prasara Madhyamalu is useful to the professional skills improvement to reach the employment opportunities in the modern society for the students.

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS:



The Subject Expert Prof. P.C. Venkateswarlu Garu suggested that the Internal marks should be in the ratio of 30:70 i.e. as same as the Krishna University, to enable the students to learn the curriculum and to gain the subject knowledge at maximum level.

The University Nominee Dr. R. Ravindrabhas Garu and another member Sri Konda Ravi Garu also suggested the same proposal in respect of subject wise Internal marks i.e. 30:70 may be followed instead of 40:60 pattern.
